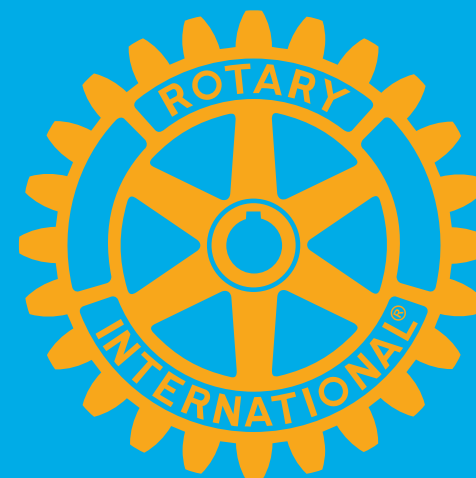
Membership dues are \$35.00 per quarter or \$140.00 per year.
